ON
ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS

This notice is provided in an effort to give you information regarding required electrical permits.

An electrical work permit is required on all new and/or altered wiring. There is a fee required for this permit. Permits can be obtained from the Department of Labor and Industries Office or on-line at www.lni.wa.gov.

An electrical inspector is in the Mason County area on designated days. Contact the Department of Labor and Industries at the phone number listed below for days scheduled in your area.

The electrical inspector will leave a gold sticker on your meter base if the service has been approved. It is the customer's responsibility to notify the serving utility of approvals. You can either call in the designated numbers on the gold sticker, or you can bring in your electrical work permit application copy which has been signed off by the state inspector. PUD 1 must have the approval before service connection can be scheduled.
