Jocelyne presented the Union Water System Plan. She stated that the new proposed system will have some stand-by storage and also have room for 20 years worth of growth. Main components of this plan include: replacing water mains, upsizing to 4-6 inch pipe from 2-3 inch pipe, and making sure that the system can accommodate existing fire flow. The district is looking at some growth occurring in this system within the next five years (20-30 more connections). One of the biggest issues is the pressure relief valves.

No public comments or questions were made. The commissioners suggested that Jocelyne meet with the new fire chief and discuss ongoing maintenance on the hydrants.
