Description of Proposal

Mason County PUD 1 owns, operates, and maintains 74 individual water systems within Mason County. The District has prepared the Canyonwood Beach Water System Plan Part B as required by the Washington State Department of Health and per WAC 246-290-100. The Plan presents the Districts water system capital facilities and O&M “roadmap” for the next ten years and beyond.

The Canyonwood Beach Water System Plan Part B demonstrates the Districts, operational, technical, managerial, and financial capability to achieve and maintain compliance with relevant local, state, and federal plans and regulations; and demonstrates how the system will address present and future needs in a manner consistent with other relevant plans and local, state, and federal laws, including applicable land use plans.

The Water System Plan includes planning, water quality, financing, operation, and maintenance management of water systems within Mason County, WA.

The Canyonwood Beach Water System is located on Harstine Island in Mason County, Wa. Township 20N, Range 02W, Section 01 SW NE. The water system plan itself is not a project however, only a planning document.
