ADDENDUM

Bidder shall sign and attach a copy of this Addendum with Bid Proposal.

Changes and clarifications to the Bid Documents and Plan-Set for the above-referenced project are as follows:

- 1. <u>If there are any potential supply chain or other issues that may push out target completion dates</u>, <u>include those estimated dates on the bid proposal</u>.
- 2. <u>MCPUD1 does not typically approve change orders unless there are errors, unintentional omissions, or</u> <u>the change order is initiated by MCPUD1.</u>
- 3. <u>MCPUD1 will notify plan holders when survey and equipment/pole stakes are set. Tentative completion</u> <u>date is March 19th</u>
- 4. <u>Can use 2/0 copper neutral bus (Asbury loop) instead of 4/0 as depicted on construction unit UVG. Size</u> <u>crimps and connectors accordingly.</u>
- 5. <u>Contractor responsible for dust abatement and any road repairs (gravel fill) to Dark Rd. Our customers</u> are letting us use the road to access the equipment storage area and we want to be respectful to them.
- 6. Are there any traffic control time restrictions?
 - a. No. Daytime hours are preferred.
- 7. Who installs communication conduit?
 - a. Contractor will install and stub communication conduit for participating communications companies. Hood Canal Communications (HCC) and Lumen (expected).
- 8. Who provides communication conduit?
 - a. Participating communication companies. Hood Canal Communications (HCC) and Lumen (expected).
- 9. <u>Can MCPUD1 and communications be in the same bore?</u>
 - a. Yes. But make sure that clearances are maintained in the trenches.
- 10. What to do with removals?
 - a. Contractors to provide dumpster(s) for scrap.
 - b. Reusable poles and other material can be left onsite for MCPUD1 to pick up.
- 11. Is there an Engineer's Estimate?
 - a. Yes. On page 5 of the Bid Binder. \$1,000,000 to \$1,300,000.
- 12. Can asphalt be open cut?
 - a. Yes. On Duckabush Rd near HWY 101 where the road will eventually be redone. For other specific locations, ask MCPUD1.
- 13. Pole removal near archeologically significant area, per drawing P1.2

- a. Contractor can cut pole(s) at ground level or simply top the pole(s).
- 14. Vault VN6 (Per drawing P2.1) distance from fog line.
 - a. The roadside/long side edge of vault VN6 is 17' from the fog line.
- 15. Access to water side of HWY 101
 - a. Pads can be laid down to access the waterside of the highway to install poles.
 - b. Nighttime work allowed if tides are an issue.
- 16. <u>Minimal tree trimming will likely be required for the poles installed on the water side of HWY 101.</u>
